# FOREWORD by Comd 25 Div / Chief Armour Officer

SAF Armour was first unveiled to an adoring Singapore public 35 years ago, on 9th August 1969, when 18 AMX-13s rolled in front of City Hall in a mobile column in celebration of our 4th National Day.
