

ADMM-Plus Maritime Security Field Training Exercise

Co-organised by Singapore and the Republic of Korea, the ASEAN Defence Ministers' Meeting (ADMM)-Plus Maritime Security Field Training Exercise 2019 saw multinational participants take part in various maritime security drills.

Multinational assets involved in the exercise



1 SECURING OF KEY INSTALLATION
Upon learning of an intrusion into a key installation (ROKS *Cheonjabong* simulating an oil rig), ADMM-Plus ships are activated to retake control, interdict the hostile vessels surrounding the key installation and recover the oil rig crew who were forced to jump overboard.

2 SENSE-MAKING & INFO-SHARING
The Information Fusion Centre in Singapore sense-makes from various sources and informs the ships at sea of a potential hijacking. The ADMM-Plus ships exchange information and work together to locate vessels of interest.

3 HELICOPTER OPERATIONS & REPLENISHMENT AT SEA
The ADMM-Plus ships conduct helicopter cross-deck landings and replenishment at sea drills to build confidence and practical cooperation.

4 COMPLIANT BOARDING OPERATION
Upon locating a vessel of interest, boarding teams are deployed to conduct checks.
