### INTRODUCTION



stablished by MINDEF in 1984, the Advisory Council on Community Relations in Defence (ACCORD) was a channel for the community to provide feedback on issues concerning Singapore's defence. To deepen engagement with employers, educational institutions, family members and members of the broader community, as well as facilitate initiatives from the community that support National Service (NS) and defence, ACCORD was restructured in August 2014 with three sub-councils formed under its ambit, namely, the Employer and Business (E&B) Council, the Family and Community (F&C) Council and the Educational Institutions (EI) Council.

Besides actively engendering public support for NS, ACCORD is instrumental in the development and implementation of many ground-up initiatives that support NS and defence. The revamped Total Defence Awards (TDA) and the launch of the NS Mark Accreditation Scheme are important examples of ACCORD's contributions.

From developing the initiatives to determining the recipients of TDA, ACCORD and its councils have made great strides in putting advocacy for NS into action.



he Total Defence Awards (TDA) were established in 1986 to recognise employers and civil resource owners who have demonstrated exemplary support for National Service (NS) and Total Defence (TD). In 2015, TDA was revamped to recognise a wider array of stakeholders including educational institutions, community support organisations and individuals. The Home Team National Service Awards for Employers were also integrated with the TDA in 2015. With the launch of the NS Mark Accreditation Scheme in 2016 to acknowledge employers who have pledged support for NS or demonstrated support and advocacy for NS and TD, the TDA becomes the highest nationallevel accolade that recognises exceptional acts of support and advocacy efforts towards strengthening the defence of our nation.


## WHAT CHALLENGES DID THE POSTPONEMENT POSE AND HOW DID YOU OVERCOME THEM?

## WHY DID YOU CUT SHORT YOUR HONEYMOON FOR WEI NIEN TO ATTEND HIS ICT?

last ICT (In-Camp Training) with them. And what better way to spend your last ICT than with a team that you enjoy being with? Of course I had to agree! While the honeymoon is usually a significant occasion for newly-weds, I understand my husband's NS responsibilities, his need to be a role model to his fellow NSmen, and the importance of his ICT. Hence, I was fully supportive and willingly agreed to reduce our honeymoon from 21 days to nine.

### HOW DID YOU SUPPORT YOUR HUSBAND IN HIS NS COMMITMENTS?

My husband enjoys his NS duties! He believes that being in the SCDF (Singapore Civil Defence Force) allows him to contribute to Singapore. I support him by updating his ICT schedule in our shared Google calendar, encouraging him

and accompanying him for his IPPT (Individual Physical Proficiency Test) training sessions, sending him to his ICT and picking him up after ICT, helping to run errands for his parents, and accompanying him to SCDF events. At first, I would ask questions like, "Why do you have to go again?" However, after meeting his teammates, I understand why he enjoys their company — they are a really sincere bunch! My persistence in urging him to exercise paid off with him achieiving either Gold or Silver IPPT awards since 2013. I am definitely proud of him!

### WHY DID YOU CHOOSE TO DOWNLOAD THE 'MYRESPONDER' MOBILE APP?

My husband suggested that I 'volunteer' because he felt that I could contribute in my own way. He was right! I have a strong conviction to set things right and ensure safety. For instance, I will call the Land Transport Authority immediately when I notice that a traffic light is not working or notify the National Environment Agency when I see a fallen tree. company that provides technical support and services to banks, schools and corporate offices. Singaporean male employees make up a significant 98% of our staff strength. Having served NS, I understand that NSmen form the backbone of our defence to ensure the continued survival and prosperity of our home country.

I believe that employers play an important role for NSmen. We try to get the very best out of all our employees and also want the best for them. I constantly check with my employees to see how we, as a company, can do more to help them manage their NS responsibilities to benefit everyone.

## HOW DOES YOUR COMPANY MOTIVATE YOUR NSMEN TO MAINTAIN THEIR FITNESS FOR THEIR ANNUAL IPPT AND PREPARE FOR ICT?


We meet once or twice a month to jog together. We emphasise the importance of maintaining our physical fitness and encourage our NSmen to exercise regularly and be ready for their IPPT (Individual Physical Proficiency Test). Having physically fit employees also benefits the company and hence, we have a small fund to incentivise NSmen to do well in their IPPT.

For our NSmen who have to undergo longer ICTs (In-Camp Trainings), we cater off-days or time off for them to rest and prepare. The protected time allotted also allows them to purchase any missing item required for their ICT or make the necessary exchanges at their camps before the reporting day.

## WHAT OTHER INITIATIVES HAVE YOU IMPLEMENTED IN SUPPORT OF YOUR NSMEN?

Our employees are like family and we are more than happy to help one another. Our HR department provides 'auto-approved' financial assistance such as advance salary payment to our NSmen before or during their ICT cycles.

For our NSmen who have returned from their ICT, our team managers would usually check with them on their ICT experience, how they fared in their IPPT, and encourage them to look forward to receiving their IPPT incentives. Before SAF Day, we send memos to our NSmen, encouraging them to don their NS uniform with pride, if it is allowed at their worksite.

We make necessary arrangements for their duties to be distributed among team members and give them peace of mind to concentrate on their ICT (In-Camp Training). Should an NSman



## HOW DOES YOUR COMPANY EMBODY SUPPORT FOR TOTAL DEFENCE?

We provide emergency ambulance services in

Singapore and support the SCDF (Singapore Civil Defence Force) by increasing the outreach to patients during emergency. We supported almost 13% of the 182,502 EMS (Emergency Medical Service) calls registered by SCDF in 2017.

Our managers make special efforts to engage all our staff so that we all have the same goal, and see that every process, however minor it may seem, is crucial in ensuring the smooth running of the EMS.

We also encourage our team to be ready to respond to any call for help. As trained first responders, our staff had, on numerous occasions, assisted others in times of need even when they were off duty. They were also encouraged to download the 'myResponder' mobile app so that they could respond to others along their path. To us, Total Defence is an approach to life where we look out for one another and are ready to help when called upon.


## HOW DOES THE COMPANY ENSURE UNDISRUPTED SERVICES TO SCDF FOR NATIONAL EMERGENCIES?

We develop and maintain our emergency plans with SCDF and actively update the plans in consultation with SCDF. We consistently exceed expectations in clinical standards, cases documentation and response time. We also maintain a strict operational uptime with sufficient manpower, vehicles and equipment. The operational team is always on standby to respond to any situation that may arise. We also invest in additional resources to support the SCDF during major events such as the Singapore Grand Prix.

## HOW DID YOUR COMPANY GO THE EXTRA MILE TO STRENGTHEN SUPPORT DURING NATIONAL EMERGENCIES?

Due to the increased number of emergency calls, we readily extended our operational hours

need to maintain the emergency ambulance equipment, we worked closely with the SCDF to review and upgrade the equipment within the stipulated timeline. We also supported the SCDF by helping their paramedic trainees gain practical experience through on-the-job training modules while attached to our ambulances. We believe that it is our duty to continually strive to provide the best EMS to SCDF and Singapore.

### WHY DO YOU SUPPORT NS AND YOUR NSMEN?


In June 2018, in support of SAF Day 2018, we renamed the app 'SaluteNSMen.SG' and it has more than 40,000 user engagements as of August 2018. During the SAF Day Recognition Campaign 2018, more than 500 merchants held promotions for NSmen through SaluteNSMen.SG. The platform could also include functionalities such as Interest Group activities to generate awareness of NS and the importance of NS among the wider community.

## WHY DID YOUR COMPANY GO THE EXTRA MILE IN ADVOCATING THE IMPORTANCE OF NS?

I feel strongly that the safety and security of our nation must not be taken for granted. During emergencies such as the SARS (Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome) epidemic in 2003, Singapore was able to immediately tap into a pool of NSmen to provide operational and logistical support to help contain the epidemic. I still remember the seriousness of the SARS outbreak as I was overseeing

communications with my engineers who were supporting the healthcare sector. The frequency of cyber and terrorist attacks in recent times continues to remind us that we must always be on our guard.

Also, in line with our corporate value of 'Humanity', I welcome the opportunity to contribute to defending our country and enhancing our Corporate Social Responsibility for the betterment and sustainability of our society and nation.

notification so that work assignments and covering plans can be developed early to ensure continuity at work.







## HOW HAS FFL BEEN REACHING OUT TO NSMEN AND THEIR FAMILIES?

FFL works closely with community partners to reach



# HOW DOES SICCI REACH OUT TO MEMBERS TO ADVOCATE SUPPORT FOR NS AND NSMEN?

As one of Singapore's most respected and active business chambers providing a platform for enhancing interaction and information exchanges for business promotion and development for our members, SICCI continuously reaches out to our members on NS and NSmen initiatives through EDM blasts and at our networking sessions. 
## WHAT CAN THE BUSINESS COMMUNITY DO TO ENSURE GREATER COMMUNITY SUPPORT FOR NS?
